

HHHA POOL RULES

Posted Rules:

1. No Running or shoving, throwing people into the pool, or shoulder riding in the pool.
2. Profanity will not be tolerated.
3. No hanging on the ropes.
4. Only children 4 and under are allowed in the baby pool. Parents are responsible for their children in the baby pool.
5. Any child under 10 must be accompanied by a parent, guardian, or a designated child of at least 15 years old.
6. Children 10 and over are permitted to attend the pool until 6 pm without a parent or guardian if they pass an approved swim test administered by the pool staff.
7. After 6 pm all children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older.
8. You must shower before entering the pool if you have sand, dirt, grass, etc. on your person.
9. Please close the gate when entering and leaving the pool.
10. A 10 minute break for adult swim will be called at 10 minutes before each hour. Anyone under the age of 18 must exit pool and remain out of pool during the break. Swim at your own risk during this time, as lifeguards will not be on duty.
11. One child may accompany one adult in the pool during the 10 minute break for the purpose of swim instruction. This is not to interfere with adults swimming laps.
12. No loud radios. No smoking. No smokeless tobacco. No vaping.
13. No floats over 4 feet in length at the 3 feet end of the pool.
14. All children who are not potty trained must wear swim diapers.
15. Glassware is not allowed in the pool area. If you are over 21 years of age and choose to consume alcoholic beverages, please use a plastic generic container. If anyone shows signs of being intoxicated, you will be asked to leave the pool. If you refuse to leave, police will be called.
16. All food must be consumed 5 feet beyond edge of pool.
17. No balloons are allowed in the pool area or any other items that could interfere with the drainage and filtration systems.
18. This pool is for the **EXCLUSIVE** use of the Hidden Harbor residents and their guests. Everyone must register with the lifeguards upon entering.
19. Any person entering the pool during nonbusiness hours or damaging HH property at any time will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
20. **The Lifeguards are the final authority.** Disciplinary action can and will be taken if the lifeguards feel it is necessary.
21. In case of an emergency dial 911.
22. Residents of Hidden Harbor with an outstanding HOA dues balance as of May 1st of the current year will not be permitted use of the pool.
23. There is a \$3.00 charge for all guests who are a resident of Hamilton County and are **NOT** immediate family. Immediate family includes: parents, children and grandchildren. There will be no charge for resident family members or their minor children or grandchildren, or resident guests from outside the county.
24. All guests **MUST** accompany a resident
25. Strick adherence to the posted Lightning/Storm policy is required. The Lifeguard is the final authority.
26. Any person with an infectious or communicable disease is prohibited from utilizing the pool, including persons with open lesions, blisters and cuts or rashes.
27. Our Slackers Swim Team utilizes the pool for practice and meets. The pool will be partially occupied during swim team practice and closed during swim meets. Practice and meet schedules are posted at the pool.

NON POSTED RULES

1. Residents of Hidden Harbor that have an outstanding balance as of May 1st of the current year will not be allowed use of the pool.
2. There will be a \$3.00 charge for all guests of a resident within Hamilton County. There will be no charge for resident family members or their minor children or grandchildren, or resident guests from outside the county.

SWIM LESSONS

The pool is for HH residents and their guests only. All activities that occur at this site are under HH Board supervision. From time to time the Board receives requests from swim instructors that swim lessons be given with the use of the pool facilities. Since the neighborhood benefits from swim lessons in general and it is in the better interest of our community as a whole, the Board has agreed to allow certain qualified swim instructors to conduct private swim lessons with proper supervision and advanced notice to the Pool manager.

Guidelines

1. The Board member responsible for the pool operations determines the number of persons needed for swim lessons and determines the persons approved to conduct them. Swim lessons are to be given only by persons appropriately certified and approved by this Board member.
2. Swim lessons are allowable only during hours when the pool is open to all HH residents.
3. Approved swim lessons may continue during adult swim given that the instructor is with the student and provides direct supervision during the scheduled lesson period.
4. HSHA is compensated at the rate charged for pool guests when swim lessons are given to non-residents.
5. All residents receiving swim lessons must be in compliance with the HH biannual assessments policies.

Instructor Requirements

All swim lesson instructors are required to take the following steps prior to giving swim lessons at HSHA pool facilities:

1. Request permission to conduct private swim lessons from the Board member responsible for pool operations.
2. Be approved by the Board.
3. Meet the same water safety and CPR requirements as the lifeguard staff.
4. Arrange swim lesson times in advance with the pool managers or head lifeguards.
5. Notify the pool manager or head lifeguards of any scheduling changes.
6. Comply with all HSHA policies and all pool policies.
7. Provide proof and/or copies of the above requirements upon request by the Board, pool managers, or any other appropriate third party.

Please note that these are general guidelines and they may be amended or changed at any time. Also, these privileges may be revoked at any time without notice by the Board or Pool Managers.
